

Kankakee Journal: Funeral services for Mrs. Frank Tobenski, 61, of RR 1, Irwin, who died Wednesday, were held Saturday morning at St. James Church, Irwin. The Rev. Stanislaus Gryga was celebrant of the solemn requiem high mass. The Rev. George Bubnik was the deacon and the Rev. Basil Doyle the sub deacon. Rites Saturday At Irwin For Mrs. Frank Tobenski Funeral services will be at 10 a.m. Saturday in St. James Church, Irwin, for Mrs. Frank Tobenski, 61, RR 1, Kankakee, who died Wednesday in Weiss Memorial Hospital, Chicago. She had been ill three months. Friends may call at the Clancy Funeral Home from 7 p.m. today until time of services. The rosary will be recited in the funeral home at 8 p.m. Friday. Burial will be in Mt. Calvary Cemetery, Kankakee. A lifelong resident of Kankakee County, Mrs. Tobenski was born Aldea Kerouac, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Philip Kerouac, April 22, 1898, in Bourbonnais Township. Since her marriage Feb. 12, 1919, in Manteno to Frank Tobenski she had been a rural resident of Irwin. She was a member of St. James Church and of the Altar and Rosary Society of the church. Mrs. Tobenski is survived by the husband, Frank; sons, Floyd, Kankakee, and Harold, Herscher; daughters Mrs. Ralph Cowan, Bradley, and Mrs. Merlyn Witheft, Buckingham; nine grandchildren; brothers, Philip, Viateur, Elmer and Roosevelt Kerouac, all of this community; and sisters, Mrs. Arthur DuBois and Mrs. Homer Guimond, Kankakee, Mrs. William Bissonnette, Detroit, and Mrs. Richard Renwick, Manteno.
