

8 Admitted To Citizenship

Eight men and women were today admitted to citizenship in the United States, at a brief ceremony conducted in naturalization court before Supreme court Justice Davis.

Pericles Demetrios Taslopoulos, of 86 Lent street, a native of Greece and one of the new citizens, was permitted to change his name to Peter Doshier.
