Daniel M. Kryznowski, 60, 1380 N. E. Lennington Circle, died suddenly at 2:30 p.m. Sunday at St. Mary's Hospital. He was born April 14, 1920, in Kankakee to Mr. and Mrs. Walter Kryznowski. He was a 43-year employee of the Mobil Chemical Co. Mr. Kryznowski was a member of St. Stanislaus Church, a member of St. Bernard's Lodge, a member of the Moose Lodge. He was also a member of the Kankakee American Legion Post 85, a member of the United Steelworkers Union, Local 14728. Survivors include his wife, the former Marie Kerouac, to whom he was married June 1, 1946, at St. Joseph's Church, Manteno; two sisters, Bernice Seifert of Bradley and Theresa Stanek of Kankakee; two brothers, Raymond of Bradley and Floyd of Kankakee. His parents are deceased. A funeral mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Wednesday at St. Stanislaus Church, the Rev. Michael Sawlewicz officiating. Visitation at the Clancy Funeral Home will be from 2 p.m. Tuesday and before the services Wednesday. Burial will be in All Saints Cemetery, Bourbonnais, where military rites will be conducted by members of the Kankakee American Legion Post. The rosary will be recited at the funeral home at 8 p.m. Tuesday. A memorial has been established in Mr. Kryznowski's name.
