

## EDMOND LEBOURDAIS

**BRUNSWICK**—Edmond LeBourdais, 88, a resident of Brunswick 70 years, died at his home on High street, Wednesday night, following a three weeks' illness.

Born at L'Islet, Quebec, he was the son of Joseph and Marcelina Kirouac LeBourdais. He married



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Helen Blanchard 65 years ago last January, and to them were born 12 children, eight of whom survive.

Mr. LeBourdais was the last of a family of 18. His sister, Mrs. Eugenie Mercier, 101, died in April at L'Islet. Mr. LeBourdais was the uncle of the wife of Premier Adelard Godbout of Quebec.

Surviving are the widow, four daughters, Helen and Zoe LeBourdais of Brunswick, Mrs. Alphonzo Saindon of Topsham, and Mrs. Arthur Lemarre of Dorchester, Mass.; four sons, George of Brunswick, Adelard and Noe of Lewiston, and Dr. G. T. LeBourdais of Biddeford; 31 grandchildren; and 15 great-grandchildren.

Mr. LeBourdais was a member of St. John's church, Holy Name society, and the third order of St. Francis.
