Edmond Kirovac, greenskeeper, at 57 Edmond "Peter" Kirovac of Taunton, a greenskeeper, died Thursday at the Lahey Clinic in Burlington after a lengthy illness. He was 57. Born in Malden, Mr. Kirovac was raised in Foxboro and Sharon. A former resident of Dennis and Sandwich, he had lived in Taunton for the last 23 years. After graduating from Sharon High School in 1957, he studied turf management at the University of Massachusetts at Amherst. Mr. Kirovac was a greenskeeper at the Sharon Country Club, Blue Hills Country Club and the Dennis Greens Golf Course. He assisted in the construction of the Dennis Greens Golf Course. He also worked for the Northgate Condominium Association in Waltham for the last seven years before his illness. Mr. Kirovac is survived by his wife, Marilyn N. (Skiendiel); two sons, Jeffrey J. of Commerce, Mich., and Andrew P. of Chelmsford; two brothers, John D. of California and Stephen P. of Colorado; a sister, Sally K.
