

Edouard Davidson

Edouard Davidson, an employe of Fortin and Gravelle, tobacconists in Hull for 30 years, died unexpectedly at his home, 22 Vaudreuil street, Hull, yesterday. He was in his 64th year.

Born in Hull, he was educated there and 43 years ago married the former Emilia Kirouac, who survives. He retired several years ago. Mr. Davidson was a member of St. Bernadette church.

Surviving in addition to his widow, are two sons, PO. Leo Davidson, RCAF, who is a prisoner of war in Germany, and Henri Davidson, well known local musician; a daughter, Yvonne, at home, and a sister, Mrs. Ulric Carisse of Hull.

The body is resting at the parlors of the Gauthier funeral home, 101 Notre Dame street, Hull, from where the funeral will be held on Monday morning to St. Bernadette church for requiem high mass at eight o'clock. Burial will be at Notre Dame cemetery.
