Cumberland- Edward F. Mulholland, 85, of Cumberland, passed away on Saturday, May 24, 2025 at HopeHealth Hultar Hospice Center, Providence. He was the beloved husband of Marianne B. (Tepper) Mulholland. They had been married for 63 years. Born in Pawtucket, he was a son of the late Hugh P. and Rose Marie (Kirouac) Mulholland and had lived in Cumberland since 1966.

Through his years of participation with the RI Chapter, he chaired many committees including the Audit and Education Committees. He was a Past President of IREM's RI Chapter No. 88.
