"George W. McIntosh

Dies Sunday At 93

George W. McIntosh, 93, 2112 Walnut, a former county assessor, died Sunday in St. Anthony hospital at Hays where he had been a patient since July.

Mr. McIntosh was preceded in death by his wife, Minnie, in 1930.

He moved to Rome, Kans., with his parents in 1879 and the family moved to Hays in 1880. In 1882 the family moved to a farm near Catherine.

Mr. McIntosh was a life-long member of the Episcopal church and held membership in Modern Woodman Lodge.

Survivors are two sons, Walter, Hays, and Robert, Glenrock, Wyo., and a sister, Mrs. George Balls, Hays.

Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Wednesday in Mall's Morford Chapel in Hays. Rev. Howard S. Trask will officiate. Burial will be in Mt. Allen cemetery in Hays.

The body will lie in state at Mall's Morford Chapel from 10 a.m. Tuesday until the hour of the service."
