

TAUNTON – Jacqueline A. Presbrey, 50, formerly of East Taunton on and most recently of Taunton, died suddenly at her home Monday, April 28, 2008. Born in New Bedford, the daughter of Claire (Hallsworth) Maynard of East Taunton and the late George Maynard, she was the wife of Wendell B. Presbrey, Jr.

She was formerly employed by the Balfour Company in Attleboro from 1981-1997, prior to the company's relocation to Texas. She was also formerly employed by Dyecraftsmen, Inc., in Taunton, from 1997-2002.

Mrs. Presbrey was a member of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War, Camp # 26; Major General Couch of Taunton; Company I, 5th Corps. 18 Regiment Massachusetts and a member of SUVCW Auxiliary of the Massachusetts Department. She was active as a re-enactor at ceremonial events that honored Civil and Revolutionary veterans. She was also a volunteer who placed American flags at Civil War veterans graves every Memorial Day.

Besides her husband and mother, she is survived by two sisters, Irene Sylvia of East Taunton, and Jeannine Walters of Quincy; and three brothers, Roger Maynard of Florida, Paul Maynard of East Taunton, and Donald Maynard of Taunton.
