James P. DuBois, 33, 1320 W. Station St., Kankakee, died at 5:50 p.m. Sunday, at his home, following a long illness. The son of Mr. and Mrs. Adeline P. "Andy" DuBois, he was born Oct. 21, 1950, in Kankakee. Mr. DuBois was a veteran of service with the Army in Vietnam. He had been employed at Roy Lang Oldsmobile. Survivors include a daughter, Denise and a son, Kevin, both of Bourbonnais; his mother, Theresa DuBois of Kankakee; his paternal grandmother, Elizabeth DuBois of Kankakee; two brothers; Gregory of Kankakee and Thomas of Watseka; two sisters, Mary Harpin of Bourbonnais and Jacqueline DuBois of Kankakee and one niece. His father died in 1971. Visitation at the Clancy Funeral Home will be after 4 p.m. today and until the services Wednesday. A wake service will be held at 7 tonight at the funeral home. The Rev. Edward O'Malley will be celebrant of a funeral mass at 11 a.m. Wednesday at St. Martin of Tours Church. Burial will be in Mount Calvary Cemetery. Memorials may be made to a trust fund for his children or to Riverside Medical Center. According to father's obituary, he was serving in Armed Forces in 1971. They are second cousins.
