SOUTHAMPTON - Jean-Lionel Kirouac, 63, of 85 Glendale Road, passed away Friday at home surrounded by his family and friends. He also enjoyed skiing and bicycling throughout Europe. He was a nature lover and loved bird-watching and gardening. Besides his father, Real Kirouac, of Northampton, he is survived by his wife, Cathleen C. Grady; his step-mother, Barbara (Sanders) Kirouac; three brothers, Alan Kirouac and his wife, Patricia, of Goshen, Kevin Kirouac, of Westfield, and Patrick Kirouac, of Longueau, France; two sisters, Janine Sage and her husband, David, of South Grafton, and Florence Thirry, of Saveuse, France; several nieces and nephews and his three cats, Gabrielle, Tesha and Bria, and his dog, Matty.
