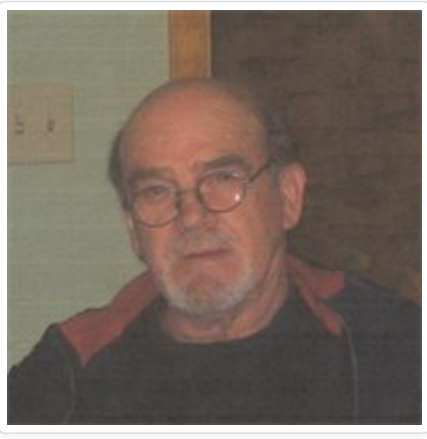




Jerry L. Menard
