Forty-seven year old Kevin Kirouac of Westfield was killed when his Harley Davidson motorcycle collided with a 1967 Chevy Camaro. It happened on North Elm Street near the corner of Lockhouse Road around 7:30 p.m. Friday night according to Lt. Paul Kousch. The Camaro was driven by 20 year-old Jacob Reed of Chesterfield. He and his two passengers were not injured. North Elm Street between Holyoke Road and Notre Dame Street was blocked-off until almost 3 o'clock Saturday morning. Lt. Hipolito Nunez said this morning that the accident is being reconstructed by the Massachusetts State Police Collision Analysis and Reconstruction Team. They are trying to determine the speed of the vehicles and if there was contact between the vehicle and the person of the motorcyclist after the initial contact, he said. Kevin M. Both motorist were traveling south when the fatal collision occurred. The Westfield Police Department Traffic Bureau requested the assistance of the Massachusetts State Police reconstruction team to investigate the fatal collision that occurred at 7:23 p.m.. State Police closed North Elm Street from Notre Dame to Holyoke Road to preserve any evidence. As of press time no names had been released pending notification of the victim's family. The Hampden County District Attorney's office was also involved in the accident investigation.
