

LEO HUBERT

Leo Hubert, lifetime resident of Concordia, died Friday, Nov. 12 at St. Joseph hospital. He was 67 and had been ill two months. Mr. Hubert was born Sept 28, 1904 at Concordia, a son of Mr. and Mrs. Paul Hubert. He was a member of the Roman Catholic Church. Mr. Hubert was married to Virginia Bessette on June 27, 1927 in Concordia. He worked for the Munch Transfer and Storage company for several years, then bought the company and operated it as the Hubert Transfer and Storage company until he retired in 1962 when he sold the business. The past three years he has-been employed by the Boogaart company.

Mr. Hubert was proceeded in death by his father and an infant son, Robert Paul.
