FRED BURTON DIED SUNDAY EVENING RETIRED FARMER DIED AT HOSPITAL AFTER AN ILLNESS OF FOUR WEEKS Fred Burton, a well known resident of Kankakee, passed away at the Barrett hospital Sunday after an illness of four weeks. He was born in St. Johns, Province of Quebec, in 1853.

When he was two years old his parents came to Bourbonnais where he went to school and grew to manhood. He married Osilda Perry, November 27, 1875. Twelve children were born to this union, six of whom survive: Mrs. Thomas Fraser, Mrs. Dan Devere, Mrs. Theodore Fritz, Jesse, Victor and Daniel Burton, of Kankakee. The widow, as well as two brothers, Louis of Bourbonnais and George of Kankakee, survive. The oldest daughter, Mrs. H. Begnoche, died about three weeks ago. After their marriage Mr. and Mrs. Burton moved to Otto township where they resided on a farm until 1920 when they moved to Kankakee, making their home on the South Side. Mr. Burton was an active member of the Irwin Court of Foresters. The funeral services will be held at St. Rose's church Wednesday morning at 9:00 o'clock. Burial will be at Mt. Calvary cemetery.
