Ludger Kerouac, 70, of 8 Hobbs av, a Nashua resident for the past 60 years, died at a local hospital Saturday evening after a short illness. He was born in St Antonin, PQ, June 9, 1878, son of the late Ludger J. Kerouac and Marie (Belanger) Kerouac.
