LEWISTON — Noella S. Kirouac, 74, of 23 Homefield St., died Sunday afternoon, May 10, at her home, surrounded by her family.

Born at St. Ludger, Quebec, Feb. 29, 1924, the daughter of Charles and Josephine Morin Baillargeon, she had been a resident of this community since 1935.

Mrs. Kirouac had attended St. Peter's School. She had worked at the Androscoggin Mill and for many years was employed as a CNA at Marcotte Home. She then worked for the Costello family of Lewiston for over 27 years.
