Doran of Philadelphia; a brother, George Abysalh; a sister, Gloria Desrochers, both of Woonsocket; a granddaughter and five step-grandchildren. The funeral will be held Tuesday at 9 a.m. from the Prata Home, 372 Broadway, with a Mass of Christian Burial at St Maria Goretti Church, Power Road, at 10. Burial will be in Notre Dame Cemetery.
