ROBERT RAYMOND KIROUAC, 51, of Norcross, Ga., formerly of Barrington and a former employee of the Acushnet Co. and the Speidel Co. in Providence, died Wednesday at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Home, Atlanta. He was the husband of Martha (Wilkinson) Kirouac. Born in Massachusetts, he lived in Barrington from 1973 to 1983. Mr. Kirouac was a graduate of Rollins College in Florida, where he played collegiate golf. He qualified five times for the U.S. Junior Championship. He was a member of the Rhode Island Country Club and was an employee in the sales and marketing department of the Coca Cola Co. in Atlanta since 1987. Besides his wife, he leaves two daughters, Amy Lee and Virginia Marie Kirouac, both of Norcross; three brothers, Edmond Pierre Kirouac of Taunton, Mass., John David Kirouac of San Juan Capistrano, Calif., and Stephen Paul Kirouac of Littleton, Colo.; and a sister, Sally Kirouac Hamilton of Attleboro, Mass. A funeral Mass will be celebrated tomorrow at 10 a.m. at All Saints Catholic Church in Dunwoody, Ga. Burial will be in Peachtree Memorial Park, Norcross.
